

Roads and Footways: Where trees overhang the road, any branches below 5.4 metres above the road must be pruned. Where trees overhang the pavement/ footway any branches below 2.3 metres above the pavement/ footway must be pruned. Any work to trees that overhang the road and/ or pavement of footway are subject to the guidance detailed above
